



SPECIFICATION SHEET # 7001, BARNWOOD FLOORING
February 3rd, 2006

1. Species

Mixed. Generally Douglas Fir, Pine, others

2. Source

Various reclaimed wood projects

3. Knots

Unlimited. Knots can be broken, loose or fallen out

4. Nail/Bolt holes

Occasional random nail holes and bolt holes; some staining around the nail holes and bolt holes or on the face is allowable

5. Checks/Cracks

Unlimited surface checking allowed; some cracking should be expected

6. Grain pattern

Vertical, flat or mixed

7. Standard Dimensions

a) Thickness: 3/4"; b) Width: Varies, depending on barnwood available at time of order; typical barnwood flooring widths can be expected to be 4" to 7"; wider (and/or narrower) barnwood flooring may be available at any given time; and c) Length: 2 to 10' with no more than 5% of total footage shorter than 4'

8. Textures Available

As-Is, Smooth, Wire-Brush and Circle-Sawn

9. Other

Characteristics apply to the flooring board's finished face.
