Douglas Fir

Flooring Type

Solid Wood, Unfinished

Profile

Tongue and Groove (T&G) with V-Groove

Knots

This material may have an average of one tight knot every six lineal feet.

Holes

Occasional nail holes. Spike holes often penetrate through the edge of the material. Staining on the face where spike holes penetrate the edge is common.

Checking/Cracks

Checking and cracking is allowed as long as the board is sound.

Grain Pattern

At least 90% of the material will have vertical grain

Standard Dimensions

a) Thickness: 3/4"; b) Width: 2.25" and 2.5"; c) Length: 2 to 14' with no more than 5% of footage to be less than 4'.

Textures Available

Smooth with a V-groove on the edge.

Appearance Variation

Boards can vary in appearance from piece to piece and even within a piece. The characteristics described on this specification sheet generally apply to each board's featured face. The opposite face and edges can differ from the featured face in texture, coloring, and other characteristics unless otherwise noted.

Additional Information

This product could be installed with the V-groove down for a square edge (flooring) product. The reverse face will have substantially more character with the spike holes coming through the edges being visible on the reverse face.
